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1. INTRODUCTION.

Your privacy is important to us. It is DAMREV's policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect from you across our website, www.damrev.com, and other sites we own and operate. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our websites, use our services, or otherwise interact with us.

2. INFORMATION WE COLLECT.

We only ask for personal information when we truly need it to provide a service to you. The types of personal information we may collect include:

3. HOW WE COLLECT INFORMATION.

We collect information by fair and lawful means, with your knowledge and consent. This may include:
